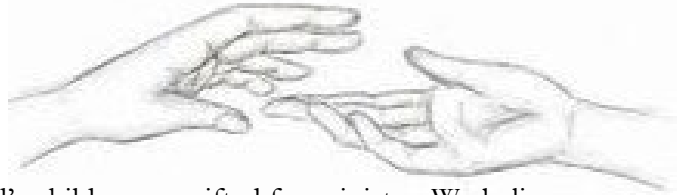


FELLOWSHIP AND VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES AT TRINITY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH, PCUSA
