think they're cool and important. One of those is Henderson County's Foam Recycling Program. Currently, you can recycle <u>clean rigid foams</u> (NO - squishies, bendies, or teenies [packing peanuts], NO food residues or tape. YES - clean dry takeout containers, electronics packaging, etc.) on first and third Tuesdays of the month at the Convenience Center (265 Convenience Center Drive). Foams are "densified" in a special melting/crushing machine, turning them into blocks of solid plastic which can then be reused by manufacturers. Open til 4pm.
